Meeting called to order by President Sue Scofield at 12:51pm.

The April Minutes were accepted as read.

Treasurer's report: The club has \$1,056.56 in checking and \$1,029.99 in savings.

Merchandise/Store: Rose has set up Café Press (cafepress.com/k9scootersnw). Clothing items have been chosen; need tax id info to set up profits and a smaller logo for some items.

Jackets: Sue said that we can get soft-shell jackets w/logo screen-printed for \$51 each for 24 jackets. They also make a simpler logo for \$25 and titling info can be embroidered on the jackets. Motion to pay Color Graphics \$25 to pay for the logo work was passed. Marleen suggested using Velcro for the titling info.

Sue showed a fold-up water bowl that our logo could be put on.

Larry mentioned that Build-a-Sign could make decals & stickers.

Pam has found a place for banners and stickers.

Titling: Sue discussed criteria. We need to update the info on the website.

Fall Event Suggestions: Larry suggested a tunnel trip & campout in Sept. He also suggested a campout at Camp K & tour of off property trails and fish ladder, perhaps the 1<sup>st</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> weekend in Oct.

2014-15 Awards: Committee formed to determine trophies and distribution – Donna M, Sue, Karla & Judge.

Race Circuit: Sue suggested a K9 Fall race to be held the 2<sup>nd</sup> weekend in Oct. A race circuit was discussed where championship points could be earned for the season. Suggested races are the 3 NWSDA dryland races, 2 K9 Scooters NW races and the Inland Empire Spokane dryland race (Dirt Rondy). Discussed adding a 3 dog Distance class (6 to 7 miles) and/or a 2 Dog Mid Distance class (approx. 5 miles). Discussed a pointing system and requiring 3 teams in a class to earn points. Motion passed to create a champion points system for the club using the NWSDA system as a model. K9 Scooters NW needs race rules. Sue and Ingrid volunteered to work on this and present at the July meeting.
